## **Sensory Herbs**

**Touch** - lamb's ear, wooly thyme, silver sage, yarrow, coneflowers **Sight** - marigolds, sage (purple, Russian, and pineapple), verbena, nasturtiums, lady's mantle, angelica, lavender, sunflowers, roses

**Taste**- chives, basil, dill, parsley, cilantro, fennel, nasturtiums, pineapple sage, mints (apple, peppermint, pineapple, spearmint), salad burnet, stevia, oregano, anise, thyme **Hearing** - Herbs such as sage, nasturtiums, and bee balm attract buzzing bees, chattering birds, and hummingbirds.

**Smell** - lavender, lemon balm, lemon thyme, lemon verbena, roses, scented geraniums, mints (peppermint, pineapple), sages, and anise
